Public Hearing on the Renewal of
Big ‘A’ Junkyard License, 192 Manalapan Road for 2018

The Public Hearing on the Renewal of the Big ‘A’ Junkyard License for 2018, of the Borough Council of the Borough of Spotswood was called to order by Council President Drozd at the Spotswood Municipal Building, 77 Summerhill Road, Spotswood, NJ.

NOTICE

This public hearing on the 2018 renewal of a junkyard license for the property located at 192 Manalapan Road, Spotswood, NJ., known as Big ‘A’ Auto Sales and Service, owners Perry and Fernando Giancola, was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6). Letters were mailed to the owners of the junkyard, and to residents within 200’ of the property, noticing them of the public hearing. Copies of this notice were posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed with the office of the Municipal Clerk. Notice on the bulletin board has remained continuously posted.

Notice of this meeting was sent to the appropriate officials of the Borough, including Patrick Diegnan, Borough Attorney, CME Associates, the Board of Health, Fire Marshall, Code Enforcement, Zoning, and Police. Departments have received the application with the Borough’s Ordinance and have set forth no objection to the junkyard’s renewal of license.
