The Public Hearing on the Immaculate Conception Carnival, of the Borough Council of the Borough of Spotswood was called to order by Council President Ricci at the Spotswood Municipal Building, 77 Summerhill Road, Spotswood, NJ.

NOTICE

This Public meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6) Notice was sent to the Home News Tribune on April 7, 2017 by the Church of Immaculate Conception for a Public Hearing for the purpose of filing an application to hold a Carnival in the Borough of Spotswood. Copies of this notice were posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed with the office of the Municipal Clerk on aforementioned date. Notice on the bulletin board has remained continuously posted.

Council President Ricci explains that this is a Public Hearing pursuant to Chapter 64 of the Borough Code, the purpose of which is to determine whether a license should be issued to the Church of Immaculate Conception to hold a carnival on church grounds in the Borough of Spotswood. Notice of this hearing was forwarded by certified and regular mail to all residents and/or property owners within 200 feet of the church property by the Church of Immaculate Conception.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Councilman Stollen made a motion to open the meeting to the public, which was seconded by Councilwoman Drozd. The Clerk called the roll, which was unanimous, and the public portion of the meeting was opened.

Paul Mastobuoni, Chairman of the Social Activities Committee for the Church of the Immaculate Conception, thanked the Council, Mayor, Fire, Police and EMS Departments for their past support and asked again for their support this year as they put on their 11th carnival at the Church of the Immaculate Conception from Tuesday, June 13th to Saturday, June 17th. The hours of operation will be Tuesday through Friday, from 6:00 pm - 11:00 pm, and Saturday from 5:00 pm -11:00 pm; fireworks will be after dark on Saturday. The ride vendor and game vendors will remain the same. We are pleased to announce this year, we have Dr. Jim Matera winner of 'Cooks vs. Cons' in the kitchen. Thank you again for your past support.

There were no questions from the public.

Councilman Stollen made a motion to close the public hearing, which was seconded by Councilwoman Drozd. The Clerk called the roll, which was unanimous, and the public hearing was closed. The Clerk announced that a resolution will be on this evenings consent agenda.
