

Meeting Minutes- February 11, 2015

CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order at 7:34 p.m.

MINUTES FROM JANUARY MEETING: Rich O'Brien asked to waive the reading of the January minutes. Dan made a motion to accept them as presented and John seconded. All were in favor.

COMPLETED PROGRAMS AND EVENTS:

- Youth Basketball: Pictures taken from the program have been posted online.

STATUS OF ACTIVE PROGRAMS:

- Adult Volleyball: No report.
- Floor Hockey: No report.
- Adult Basketball: No report.
- Indoor Soccer: The program is going well. There are currently four referees. Next year Diane will order new soccer balls. Pictures to be posted online will be taken during the program.
- Kidz Yoga: The program was full with fifteen children. It ran for six weeks and is ending February 11.
- Skating Rink: The rink has been open for five days and is going well. Recreation members agreed on a schedule to unlock the rink on weeknights and weekends. The rink will remain open as long as weather allows.

UPCOMING PROGRAMS AND EVENTS:

- Movie Night: The LEGO Movie will be shown in the high school cafeteria on Saturday, February 21 from 5:30-8:00. It has been advertized and messaging will go out again next week. The PTA will be providing free snacks and drinks. There will be a raffle for a LEGO movie kit, which cost \$30.
- Kidz Yoga 2: The program will include six sessions from February 18 to April 1. It will again be held at Schoenly School on Wednesday nights and will be capped at 15 children. There are currently 13 children registered.
- Flag Football: There are 111 children and 17 volunteers and there will most likely be 14 teams. The program will run at 9:30 A.M. and utilize both the Junior Varsity Soccer and Varsity Football fields. Diane will use Amazon to order equipment because it is cost efficient. Jim is waiting to hear back about T-shirt orders. The program will start March 22.
- Easter Egg Hunt: The program is scheduled for March 28. Tentatively, it will run from 2-4. Diane will order prizes.
- T-Ball: 29 children have registered so far. Registration will be open until March 15.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Budget update: There is currently a transitional budget. Councilman Ricci announced that the budget workshop for the borough council will be February 19.

- Website update: The draft site has been sent out to the Recreation members. Their responses are currently being accumulated and improvements will be made accordingly.
- Accounts Receivable update: No progress since last month. Recreation members still need administrator privileges.
- Spring Bus Trip (Radio City): Donna reported that there was not much of a response to the interest survey. The group voted not to run the trip. Discussion of alternative trips to be considered for the Spring ensued. No decision was reached.

NEW BUSINESS:

- S'Woodstock 2015: The first subcommittee meeting was held last Tuesday. The program will be held June 5-6. A movie aimed for children ages 5-12 will be shown on Friday and the bands will play on Saturday. No vendors will be present other than food vendors. The next subcommittee meeting will be held on February 23 at 7:30. The committee is currently brainstorming ideas in order to generate more attendees for the event.
- Adult Yoga: A new program, this will be held for five weeks in March, ending on April 2nd, one hour per session. There will be a \$60 fee to cover the costs of the teacher and registration. Electronic messaging will begin shortly.
- Rutgers Class: Will be held on a Saturday in early March in the high school media center. Will cost \$30.50 per person. Currently looking for interest in the program. More information to come.
- Steve received an email from a potential teacher for a CPR class. The teacher would charge \$30 per student. Research will be conducted on this topic for future discussion.

A motion to adjourn was made by Steve at 8:30 P.M., Donna seconded. All were in favor.
