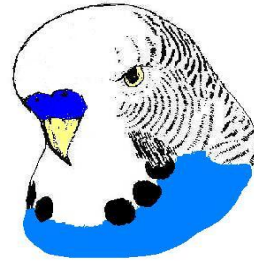

## Directions to Knights of Columbus Hall, 83 East Lincoln Ave., Monroe Twp., NJ

**It is on the left at the end of the short dead end street. Note: Hall is on East Lincoln Ave. (Monroe Twp) but there is a Lincoln Ave. (Jamesburg). Helmetta Road separates the two roads and towns.**

### **(1) Basic Directions - New Jersey Turnpike (toll) North or South to exit 8A for Jamesburg/Cranbury**

From exit 8A to the show hall is about three miles, three turns and five minutes. Stay left after toll and follow signs for Jamesburg/Monroe/Rt. 32 East. Forsgate Drive. (Rt. 612) and continue to the end of the road (fifth light). As you approach this light by the lake, stay in the left lane and go over the railroad tracks. Just before the road ends into a parking lot, turn left onto Rt. 522 West, which is East Railroad Ave. (If you are on West Railroad Ave., you turned left before the tracks.) Turn right at \*Hooker Street (Jamesburg Collision), the sixth street on the right. It becomes Helmetta Road after the sharp left bend. Proceed 2/10 of a mile and turn right onto East Lincoln Ave. (Lincoln Ave. is on left.) If you see anything that says Helmetta or Spotswood, you have gone too far.

*If you miss the right turn onto Hooker Street, stay on East Railroad Ave. for another two blocks and just before the intersection of Rt. 615 you will come to a stop sign. (Parkside Tavern) Turn right onto Lincoln Ave. Continue a few blocks to the stop sign at the intersection of Helmetta Rd. Cross this road to East Lincoln Ave.*

### **Other local routes:**

**(2) South Amboy, Old Bridge, East Brunswick, Spotswood and Helmetta corridor:** - Take Rt. 615 South to the Jamesburg/Monroe Twp border. This road is also called Bordentown Ave., Main St., Manalapan Rd. and Helmetta Rd. As you pass through Helmetta, follow Helmetta Rd. to the left. Turn left onto East Lincoln Ave. (Lincoln Ave. will be on the right.)

**(3) From the Sayreville, South River, East Brunswick area:** - Take Rt. 535 South (Cranbury Rd.) and pass through East Brunswick. Turn left onto Rt. 522 East/Rhode Hall Rd. into Jamesburg. (Rt. 522 West/Ridge Rd. is to the right.) Stay to the left at a slight fork in the road where the name changes to Gatzmer Ave. Go under the overpass and make a left onto Rt. 615/Lincoln Ave. Continue a few blocks to the stop sign at the intersection of Helmetta Rd. Cross this road to East Lincoln Ave.

**(4) From Monmouth County near Rt. 18/Rt. 9, Old Bridge, Englishtown, etc.:** - Take Rt. 520 West (Texas Rd.) through the intersection of Rt. 527 (Englishtown Rd.). Bear left onto Rt. 612 (Matchaponix Rd.). The road will become Pergola Ave. in Jamesburg. At the stop sign and intersection of Rt. 522 (Buckelew Ave.) turn right onto East Railroad Ave. Stay in the right lane to go straight after the traffic light just ahead, and then follow the **(1)** directions from East Railroad Ave. to the right onto \*Hooker Street.

**(5) From Freehold Area:** - There are three options:

**Rt. 33 West to the New Jersey Turnpike North** and then you will follow the **(1)** directions for using the Turnpike.

**Rt. 33 West to Perrineville Road**, where you will turn right at the Lobster Shanty. Stay on Perrineville Rd. all the way to the intersection of Forsgate Drive. A very large Thompson Park will be on your right and a CVS will be on the left at the traffic light. Turn right onto Forsgate Drive and then be ready to turn left at the next light after you pass over the railroad tracks. This will be Rt. 522 West/East Railroad Ave. Follow **(1)** directions from here to turning right on \*Hooker Street.

**Rt. 522 West** (also called Freehold Englishtown Rd., Water St., Wood Ave. and Buckelew Ave.) Follow for several miles through Monmouth Battlefield State Park, Tennent, and Englishtown. When you get to Jamesburg, a lake is on your left and Pergola Ave. on your right. Continue straight and the road becomes East Railroad Ave. Follow **(1)** directions for turning right at \*Hooker Street.

**(6) Using Rt. 130:** - Depending on where you are, head North or South and exit at Rt. 32 East (Forsgate Dr.) toward the NJ Turnpike and follow **(1)** directions as if you exited from the NJ Turnpike. **Or**, you may exit from Rt.130 at Rt. 522 East (Ridge Rd./Rhode Hall Rd) and continue through intersection with Rt. 535 Cranbury Rd. Remain on Rt. 522 East and follow **(3)** directions from here .

**(7) From the Trenton Area:** - I-195 East and take exit 6 for NJ Turnpike North. Exit at 8A. and then follow **(1)** directions.

**(8) NJ Atlantic Coast – including Wildwood/Atlantic City/Barnegat/Toms River/Pt. Pleasant:** - Take the Garden State Parkway North (toll) to exit 98 for Rt.138, toward Rt-34/Belmar/I-195 West/Trenton. Exit left toward Rt.34/I-195. Merge onto NJ Rt.138 West which becomes I-195 West. About 7 miles, merge onto US-9 North via exit 28B toward Freehold. Continue for 8 miles. Take the ramp toward Throckmorton St./Freehold/Englishtown and turn right onto Rt. 522 West. Then use directions for **(5) Rt. 522 West**. You also have the option of getting off Rt. 9 North sooner and taking **Rt. 33 West (5) and using the Turnpike or Perrineville Rd.**

**(9) From Brooklyn/LI,NY** - BQE or Belt Pkwy to Verrazano Bridge, then I-278 West over Gothals Bridge. Take the NJ Turnpike South to exit 8A and follow **(1)** directions.

### **(10) From the Allentown/Easton, PA and Phillipsburg/Clinton, NJ areas:**

I-78 East to I-287 South via exit 29 toward Rt. 202/206S/Somerville for about 12 miles. Use exit 9 for Rt. 514/River Rd. Turn right toward Highland Park. Follow CR-514/River Rd/NJ-18 South and NJ Turnpike signs for about seven miles. From here, either take NJ Turnpike South to exit 8A and follow **(1)** directions **or** remain on Rt. 18 South a couple miles and take Rt. 535 South (Cranbury Rd.) and follow **(3)**.

**Junior:** \$12.00/year or \$22.00/2 years for any individual who will not reach his or her 17th birthday by March 31 of the current year.

**Regular:** \$15.00/year or \$28.00/2 years - Any individual 17 or older by April 1 of the current year.

**Dual:** \$18.00/year or \$34.00/2 years - Two members of the same household that qualify for "regular" membership.

**Family:** \$21.00/year or \$40.00/2 years - Same as Dual membership, and up to two children of "Junior" status.

**Senior Citizen** (age 65 or older): \$12.00/year or \$22.00/2 years.

**Senior Citizen Dual:** \$15.00/year or \$28.00/2 years - Two members of the same household; at least one age 65 or older.

**The listed dues rates above are for memberships that will receive newsletters and club correspondence by email only. If you do not have access to a computer or want a printed version sent to you by regular mail, there is an additional fee to cover increased costs to the club. For U.S. residents, please add \$12 per year, per household membership level (\$1.00 per month). If outside the U.S., please ask the club for costs associated with postage.
