Al Galasso, (sworn in) gave testimony on behalf of the American Legion. The Legion is seeking bulk variances for the installation of a permanent oversized sign on the property. The sign is proposed to be placed 25' from the curb and will be lighted. Photographs of the sign's location have been submitted. Originally, it was intended for the sign to be 15' off the curb but due to existing power line guide wires that cannot be relocated, the sign has been moved back. Electricity for the sign will be run underground and up into the sign. The outside panel is locked preventing access to the electrical components. An existing freestanding sign will be removed.
